- **At Home Projects** - This might be cutting out letters, making crafts, or sorting classroom supplies.
- **Classroom Assistant** - Help at the request of the teacher in the room.
- **Clinic Assistant** - Work in the clinic to at the direction of the nurse.
- **Community Assistant** - Upon request of teachers be a quest speaker.
- **Duplicating** - Help duplicate materials for teachers.
- **Homerom Parent** - Help prepare for celebrations, assist teacher with field trips, serve as a class contact.
- **Landscaping** - Assist with landscaping or beautification of school grounds
- **Mentoring** - Act as an encourager, motivator for an at-risk Student
- **Office Assistants** - Help with general office duties.
- **PVO** - Assist with the Parent Volunteer Organization
- **SAC** - Attend and participate in the School Advisory Council which develops the School Improvement Plan
- **School Pictures** - Help organize students for class picture day
